ADVANCING GROWTH ACROSS LATAM

Connecting Capabilities Across Key Energy Markets

Latin America is becoming an increasingly important part of Superior Energy's international growth strategy. From Brazil's world-class offshore developments to Argentina's rapidly expanding unconventional resource plays and growing offshore activity across Trinidad, Guyana, and Suriname, the region presents significant opportunities for organic growth and deeper collaboration across Superior's business portfolio.

As customers seek more integrated solutions and larger-scale partnerships, Superior is leveraging its established presence, technical expertise, regional infrastructure, and growing breadth of capabilities to strengthen relationships with key operators and capture new opportunities across the region.



BRAZIL: EXPANDING OUR POSITION WITH PETROBRAS

Brazil remains the largest oil and gas market in Latin America and continues to be driven by the development of Petrobras' prolific pre-salt resources, which account for approximately 80 percent of the country's oil production. The market is supported by approximately three dozen active offshore rigs spanning drilling, completion, abandonment, and workover activity, creating opportunities across multiple Superior business lines.

Superior has built a strong position in Brazil and is increasingly viewed by Petrobras as a strategic service partner capable of delivering integrated solutions alongside the industry's largest providers. The Company is actively pursuing opportunities across completions, intervention services, premium drill pipe, and well-control technologies while supporting some of Petrobras' most important development programs.



The market is also creating opportunities for innovation. Superior Completion Services is working to advance technology development and local qualification programs that support future Petrobras projects, helping position the business for upcoming tender opportunities while expanding access to increasingly complex completion scopes. Brazil's regulatory framework also provides opportunities to develop new technologies locally through industry-supported research and development programs.



GLOBAL LEADERSHIP VISITS BRAZIL AND REINFORCES COMMITMENT TO THE COUNTRY'S GROWTH

Planned projects span completion programs, intervention services, workover and abandonment activity, wireline, slickline, tubular rental, and well-control support.

This collaborative approach not only strengthens Superior's value proposition but also helps customers access a broader set of technical capabilities through a single trusted partner, reinforcing the company's growing position in the Brazilian market.

ARGENTINA: POSITIONED FOR THE NEXT WAVE OF GROWTH

While Brazil represents a mature offshore opportunity, Argentina is emerging as one of the most promising growth markets in the region. Driven by continued development of the Vaca Muerta shale play and long-term plans to significantly increase both oil production and LNG exports, the market is expected to require substantial increases in drilling and completion activity over the coming years.

Argentina currently operates roughly 40 to 50 active drilling rigs, with industry forecasts projecting meaningful growth as operators work toward future production targets. Key operators including YPF and Pan American Energy continue expanding development activity, creating increased demand for drilling, completion, intervention, and production optimization services. Superior is already establishing a stronger presence in the market through wireline, perforating, production enhancement, and intervention-related services. Recent deployments of equipment and personnel from other regions have helped support growing customer engagement while laying the foundation for future expansion.

STRENGTHENING REGIONAL OPERATIONS ACROSS TRINIDAD, GUYANA, AND SURINAME

Superior Energy Services continues to strengthen its presence across the Caribbean and northern South America through the combined capabilities of Workstrings, Stabil Drill, and HB Rentals.

In March 2026, Workstrings and Stabil Drill consolidated operations into a shared facility in Trinidad under SES Trinidad, alongside HB Rentals. The shared location enhances collaboration, streamlines operations, and strengthens support for customers throughout the region.

Stabil Drill also maintains a dedicated facility in Guyana under SES Guyana, supporting activity in both Guyana and neighboring Suriname. Together, Workstrings and Stabil Drill maintain strategically located rental assets across all three countries, with Workstrings providing premium drill pipe rentals and Stabil Drill supporting BHA rental tools and services.

Recent activity includes multi-year campaign support in Trinidad and Suriname, a major drill pipe award in Guyana, and HB Rentals' turnkey offshore accommodation work in Trinidad. As operators across the region pursue larger, more complex development programs, Superior is differentiating itself by bringing together completion, intervention, well-control, production enhancement, and wellbore technologies — positioning the company to support customers across one of the world's fastest-growing offshore energy regions.

LOOKING AHEAD

As activity continues to accelerate across Latin America, Superior is focused on more than individual business opportunities. Success across the region will depend on collaboration across business units, shared technical expertise, and integrated solutions that address customer challenges throughout the well lifecycle.

From Brazil's offshore developments to Argentina's unconventional growth story and expanding activity across Trinidad, Guyana and Suriname, the opportunities ahead span multiple Superior businesses. By combining local execution with global expertise, Superior is continuing to strengthen its position as a trusted partner across one of the world's most dynamic energy regions.

STORM TOOL DEMONSTRATES STRONG PERFORMANCE IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

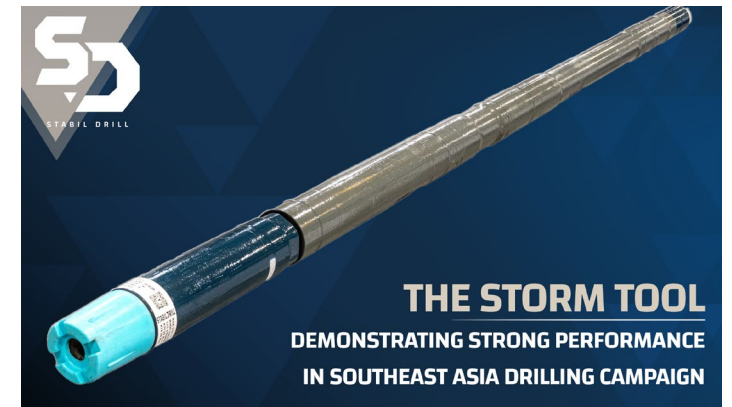
Stabil Drill recently completed a multi-well STORM Tool deployment with a major international operator in Southeast Asia, further demonstrating the tool's effectiveness in challenging drilling environments and reinforcing its position as a leading vibration mitigation solution in the region. The campaign included multiple runs across both 8 1/2 inch and 12 1/4 inch hole sections in a field known for hard formations and historically challenging drilling performance. The operator had identified vibration management as a key factor in improving rate of penetration, extending bottom hole assembly life, and achieving longer drilling intervals.

The STORM Tool was introduced as part of a direct performance evaluation against the operator's existing vibration mitigation technology. Following the initial 8 1/2 inch lateral section, the tools were inspected and found to be in excellent condition, demonstrating strong durability and reliability after drilling through demanding formations.

The positive results continued during the subsequent 12 1/4 inch section, where both rig site observations and post run data supported the benefits of the STORM Tool system. Based on these outcomes, the operator elected to run STORM again in a second 8 1/2 inch lateral section to complete a comprehensive side by side evaluation under comparable drilling conditions.

Preliminary analysis indicates that STORM delivered excellent shock and vibration reduction while supporting improved drilling performance. Combined with the tool's post run condition and overall operational results, the evaluation has positioned the STORM Tool as a strong candidate for broader deployment throughout the remainder of the drilling program.

As operators continue to focus on maximizing ROP, extending BHA life, and improving drilling efficiency, the STORM Tool continues to prove its value across demanding applications and build momentum as a preferred vibration mitigation solution throughout the Asia Pacific region.



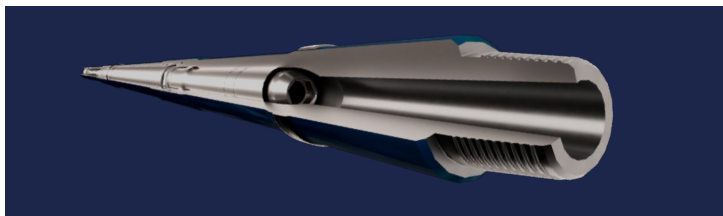

Introducing the STORM-CX

Stabil Drill has introduced the new 5.25-inch STORM-CX, an expansion of the STORM platform designed to increase customization, operating range, and downhole performance.

At the center of the redesign is an all-new dampening block that enables greater hydraulic customization to suit specific client applications and drilling conditions. A 25 percent larger operating window allows the tool to capture a broader range of torque events within a single activation setting, improving responsiveness and consistency in dynamic drilling environments.



The tool also features a larger internal diameter to reduce pressure drop while still delivering significant performance gains, including a 34% increase in torque rating, a 25% increase in back reaming capacity, and a 10% increase in weight-on-bit capacity.

Additional enhancements include a reconfigured layout that introduces self-draining capability and new catch mechanisms for improved reliability and handling. A newly engineered flex section increases bending capacity, supporting improved performance in curve sections and emerging U-turn applications.

STORM-CX represents a meaningful advancement in vibration and torque management technology, expanding the STORM platform's ability to deliver controlled, consistent performance across a wider range of drilling challenges.

Reactive Reamer Brings Smarter Wellbore Conditioning

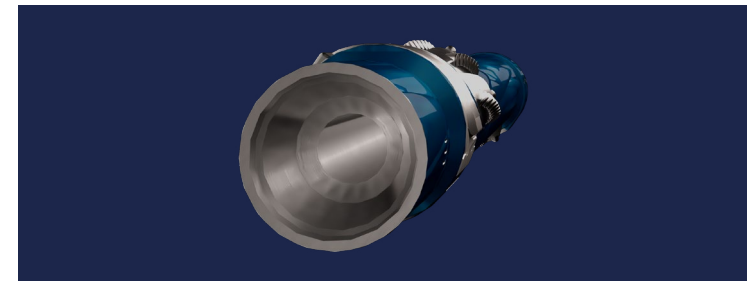
Stabil Drill continues to develop technologies that address real challenges faced by customers in the field. One upcoming launch, the Reactive Reamer, reflects that focus by offering a smarter approach to wellbore conditioning.

The Reactive Reamer was developed to address common limitations associated with traditional reaming tools. Existing solutions can introduce unwanted string torque and increase the risk of casing damage during trips. In many cases, operators are also left wondering whether the reamer delivered measurable value during the run.

The Reactive Reamer answers these challenges through a unique guard and articulation system that responds to wellbore conditions rather than continuously engaging the formation.

The protective guard helps prevent cutter engagement in full gauge hole sections and reduces the risk of casing contact, only allowing cutters to engage when undersized hole conditions or ledges require intervention.

The tool also provides value after the run. If cutter wear is present, operators have clear evidence that the tool actively engaged the wellbore and contributed to the drilling operation.



The result is a more intelligent reaming solution that enhances performance while providing greater confidence in tool effectiveness.

The first Reactive Reamer size is expected to launch in Q3 with a 6.75-inch outside diameter.

The refreshed space strengthens the working environment for employees while supporting customer engagement, collaboration, and operational execution in one of Brazil's most important energy hubs.

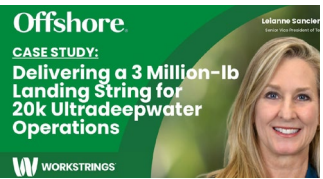

Leianne Sanclemente, Senior Vice President of Technology, was featured in [Offshore Magazine](#) discussing the engineering behind delivering a 3 million pound landing string for 20K ultradeepwater operations.



Developed for a Green Canyon 20K well, the custom FASTR 3.0 landing string system was designed to meet the requirements of 20,000 psi exploration in ultradeepwater environments.

The system successfully ran the heaviest casing load ever deployed offshore and achieved a record-breaking 2.95 million pound tensile capacity.

Extensive testing, including shear, friction weld, and combined load assessments, validated the system's structural integrity and operational reliability under extreme conditions. The project also overcame supply chain disruptions through virtual collaboration, helping ensure timely completion and deployment in the Gulf of Mexico.

12 Years LTI Free for Workstrings Aberdeen

The Workstrings Aberdeen team recently reached an exceptional milestone: 12 years without a Lost Time Injury.

This achievement reflects years of commitment, professionalism, teamwork, and personal accountability. It is the result of consistent safe work practices, thorough pre-start inspections, hazard identification, toolbox talks, and active engagement with the HSE Toolbox.

The milestone also reflects the daily application of key safety behaviors, including Think Before You Act and Trust but Verify. These principles help ensure safety is part of how teams work, communicate, and support one another.

31 MODULES. TWO VESSELS. LESS THAN FIVE WEEKS.

HB Rentals recently completed two major vessel accommodation projects involving 31 total modules across two vessels. The projects included 13 modules on one vessel and 18 modules on another, along with the supporting accessories and infrastructure required for full operation.

From design and engineering through asset modifications, transportation, installation, commissioning, and regulatory approvals, both projects were completed in less than five weeks, including one deployment to Mexico.

Projects of this size and complexity would traditionally require several months to progress through all phases of execution. These achievements were delivered while HB Rentals continued supporting ongoing rental operations, build for sale projects, and multiple additional mobilizations.

Successful execution required close collaboration across engineering, operations, manufacturing, logistics, and field service teams. The result was the safe and efficient delivery of fully integrated accommodation solutions that enabled customers to meet critical project schedules without compromise.



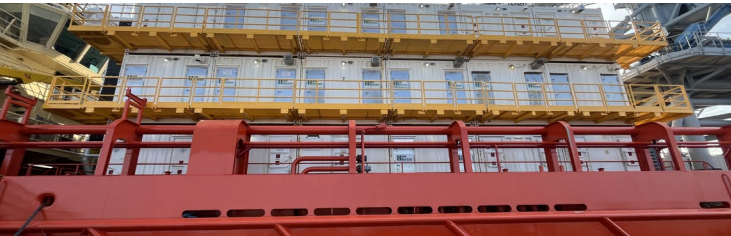

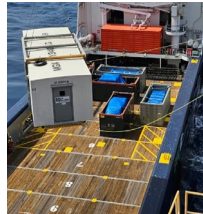

SilOff Fluid System Delivers Results in Kuwait

Warrior Energy Services recently completed a challenging cementing operation in Kuwait using a customized SilOff fluid train designed to address a demanding dual objective: curing losses and meeting Formation Integrity Test requirements.

The operation took place in a highly vulnerable loss formation at the casing shoe. This formation is known in the region for its cavernous, vuggy structure, where interconnected voids can behave like a black hole and lead to complete losses, even when the fluid in hole is switched to drill water. At the same time, the customer required a high FIT, creating a significant technical challenge.

Conventional loss control cement plugs often disappear into these formations and fail to cure losses on the first attempt, requiring multiple remedial operations before the well can progress. To address the challenge, Warrior deployed a tailored SilOff fluid train, an aggressive reactive fluid system engineered for this type of double objective requirement.

The system was designed to provide effective loss mitigation while maintaining the necessary density and compressive strength properties to meet the targeted FIT. The customized solution was developed based on regional formation characteristics and supported by a strong performance history from previous applications in similar wells.

The job was executed with careful planning and precise control of pumping parameters and fluid placement. The SilOff system performed as intended, successfully controlling losses at the casing shoe while enabling the well to achieve the targeted FIT without compromising formation integrity.

The outcome eliminated the need for remedial operations and allowed drilling activities to continue smoothly. The customer appreciated Warrior's engineered approach, which helped avoid multiple potential attempts to address the situation and resulted in significant savings in rig time.

This successful application reinforces the reliability of Warrior's SilOff technology in complex and high-risk environments, highlighting Warrior's ability to deliver fit-for-purpose solutions that address competing well objectives while ensuring customer satisfaction.

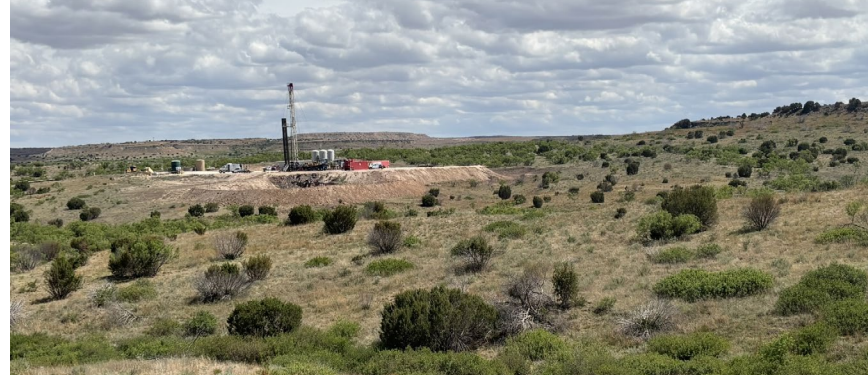

EcoReach Delivers Results in Mature Stacked Pay Reservoir

Texakoma and Superior Energy recently completed a three-stage hydraulic stimulation program on a McMordie Ranch well near Canadian, Texas, demonstrating how a controlled, low rate stimulation design using EcoReach broad-sieved non-synthetic microproppant can improve treatment placement in mature stacked pay reservoirs.

The McMordie Ranch asset includes tight, layered formations across the Atoka, Granite Wash, Cherokee, Des Moines, and Kansas City formations. Similar intervals in the field have historically been difficult to stimulate successfully using conventional sand based treatments, with previous jobs often experiencing early screenouts before planned treatment volumes could be placed.

To address these challenges, the EcoReach team designed a low rate treatment using EcoReach microproppant carried in a simple 2 percent KCl brine system. The design eliminated the need for high viscosity gel systems, complex fluid chemistry, and conventional sand transport requirements. Treatments were pumped at approximately 13 barrels per minute, compared with prior conventional frac jobs in the area that had been pumped at rates as high as 60 barrels per minute.



The program was executed from the bottom up using a plug and perforate strategy across three stages: Atoka and 13 Fingers, Granite Wash G and H, and Granite Wash E and F. Across all three stages, approximately 150,000 pounds of EcoReach proppant was successfully placed and over displaced in each stage.

Stage 3 provided one of the most important operational observations from the project. During pumping, pressure behavior indicated a likely mechanical failure of the isolation plug set above Stage 2. Under a conventional sand slurry design, this type of event would normally create a high risk of screenout, proppant banking, or sand fill in the wellbore.

The EcoReach proppant system remained pumpable. Despite the sudden pressure loss and loss of zonal isolation, the crew successfully continued the treatment and completed the stimulation without screenout, without losing the job, and without leaving proppant fill in the wellbore.



Post-job analysis confirmed that the treatments behaved within design expectations, covered the selected reservoir pay intervals, and extended fractures into the reservoir. Most importantly, the well began flowing substantial fluid volume without mechanical pump assistance, with oil cut rising to more than 70 percent over the following weeks. The McMordie Ranch project provides a strong example of how mature vertical wells in stacked pay reservoirs can be reevaluated and redeveloped using modern stimulation design and microproppant technology. It also reinforces EcoReach's ability to help operators improve treatment placement reliability in reservoirs where conventional sand frac treatments have historically struggled.

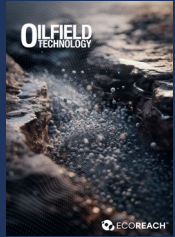

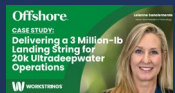
